



Deadline to apply is January 15, 2025.

Elks National Foundation - Legacy Scholarship Awards

Legacy Awards are available to children, stepchildren, grandchildren or stepgrandchildren or legal ward of an Elk. For the 2024 contest, the Elk must have joined the order on or before April 1, 2021. The Elk must also be a paid-up member through March 31, 2024. The applicant must be a high school senior. Apply at www.elks.org/legacyscholarship by February 3, 2025.

Massachusetts Elks Career/Technology Education Scholarship

For graduating high school seniors or older students who are attending a vocational/technical, one or two year Junior/Community College. There is no age limit and high school diploma or GED is not required, applicant must be an American Citizen. Applications are available at maelks.org/scholarship or contact Patty Debold. Applications are renewable for one additional year but you must apply each year. Deadline to apply is March 1, 2025.




